Qualifications:

- 1) Candidates are graduating seniors attending a public, private, parochial or home school, and reside in Downers Grove or the High School District 99 attendance area.
- 2) Candidates plan to pursue a post-secondary education.
- 3) Candidates are required to have participated in curricular music activities in high school and/or extracurricular music activities.
- 4) Composers and/or arrangers qualify for this scholarship.
- 5) Pursuit of an undergraduate music major or minor is not required.
- 6) Financial need is not a criterion for selection.

Your application will be reviewed by a Selection Committee composed of members of the community and the Rotary Club of Downers Grove. The Committee will select scholarship finalists who will be invited for a required 20 minute interview including an audition held on the evening of **Monday April 30**, **2018**. Finalists will be contacted by a Committee member with the time and location of their interview. The scholarship winner will be announced in May.
